Hydrangeas are everywhere in Georgia. I know I grew up with them around our house. I constantly picked them for my mom, and it seemed like there was always an endless supply in our garden. I later learned that it is super easy to propagate and because of that, hydrangeas basically grow themselves. Some types such as the Bigleaf hydrangeas or H. macrophylla, can change flower color depending on what's in the soil. Want darker blue flowers, lower the soil pH. Increase your pH and make colors pop like pink and reds. Be careful though because a pH above 7.5 can damage your hydrangeas. Also, hydrangeas do lose color as they start to fade. Usually this happens in the Fall.

Hydrangeas are considered shrubs and grow in hardiness zones 3-7. Hydrangeas like the sun of the day with shade in the evening. They can grow up to 15' tall and will spread throughout your garden if you let them. They bloom in Spring and Summer, while Fall is the best time to plant them, followed by Spring. Our favorite types are Oakleaf, Bigleaf, and Endless Summer.
